Celebrated World Environment Day, National Tree Day and National Threatened Species Day; Planted 200 street trees as part of Cool Towns Urban Forest Project; Opened Tweed Coast Koala Research Hub; Awarded Sustainable Agriculture Small Grants; Restored 20ha flying fox habitat.

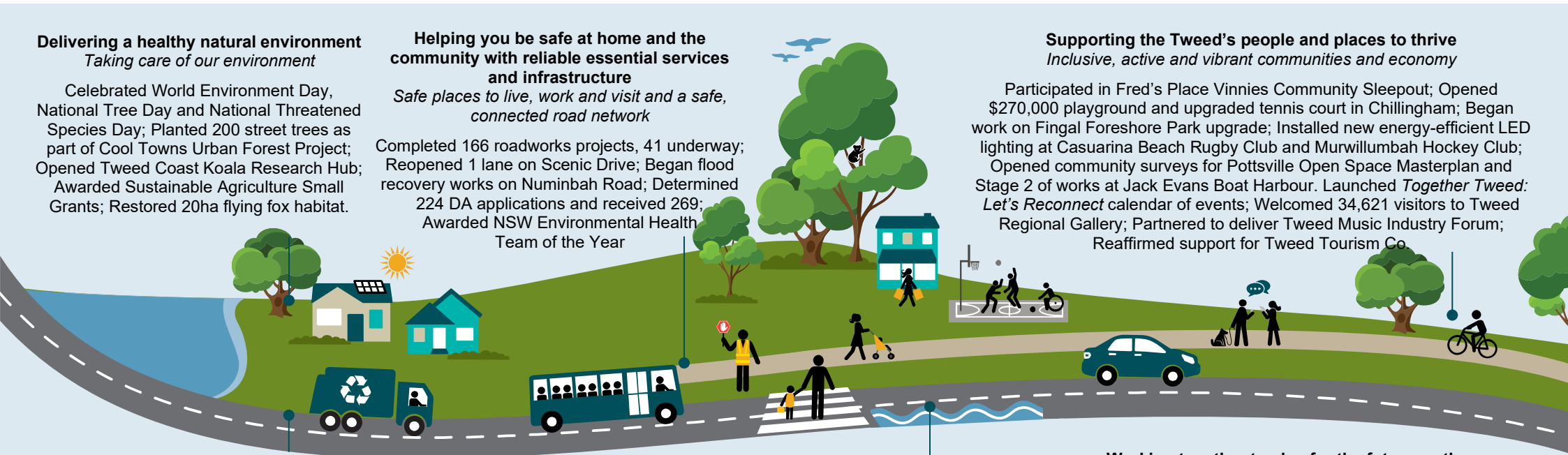

Participated in Fred's Place Vinnies Community Sleepout; Opened \$270,000 playground and upgraded tennis court in Chillingham; Began work on Fingal Foreshore Park upgrade; Installed new energy-efficient LED lighting at Casuarina Beach Rugby Club and Murwillumbah Hockey Club; Opened community surveys for Pottsville Open Space Masterplan and Stage 2 of works at Jack Evans Boat Harbour. Launched *Together Tweed: Let's Reconnect* calendar of events; Welcomed 34,621 visitors to Tweed Regional Gallery; Partnered to deliver Tweed Music Industry Forum; Reaffirmed support for Tweed Tourism Co

Introduced balloon ban to reduce destructive impact on marine life; Diverted 60.5% waste from landfill; Began upgrade of Stotts Creek Resource Recovery Centre; Held climate change and agriculture adaptation awareness workshop to help develop drought resilient beef and dairy farms in the Tweed.

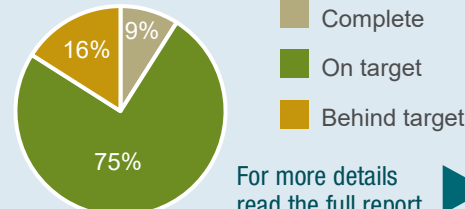
