SUMMARY OF REPORT:

Council has received a grant funding agreement for the Tweed River Regional Museum Project for up to \$1,100,000 (GST Inclusive) from the Federal Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Local Government under the Better Regions program.

Council is required to execute this agreement and return it the Department by 3 July 2009.
