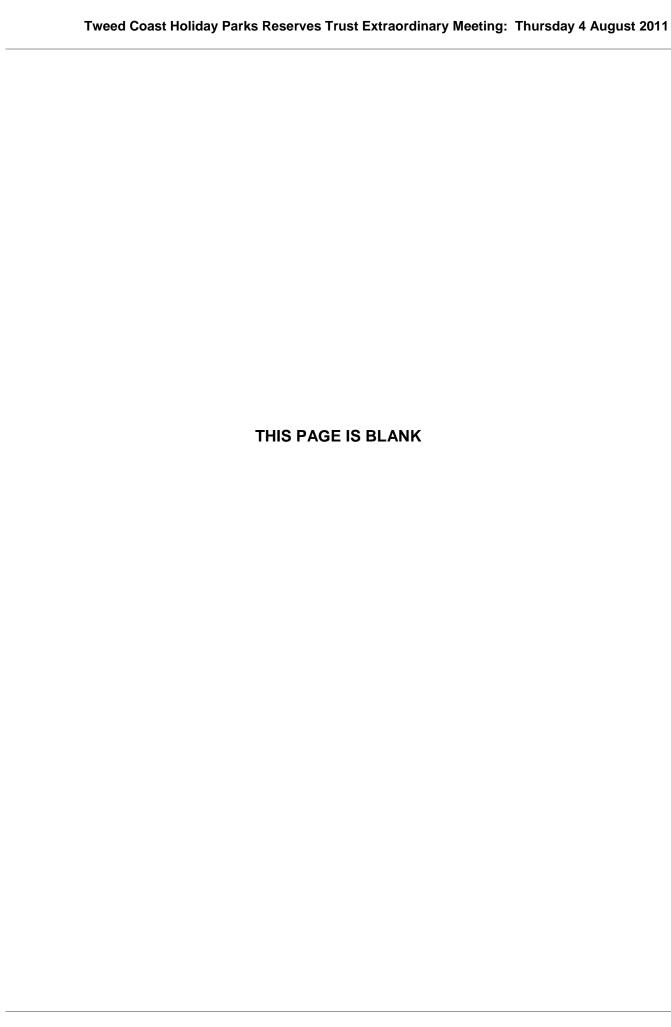

- 1. Includes the feasibility of a terminal wall of a suitable type to be extended across the potential threat area.
- 2. Integrates the urgency work that has already been carried out into that long term solution.
- 3. Continues to pursue the adopted Coastline Management Plan Strategy of providing sand nourishment to Kingscliff Beach.
- 4. That this request be forwarded to Council for their consideration at the August 2011 meeting.
- 5. The Trust requests Council to advise the State Government of the direction that the Trust and Council is heading with a view to obtaining State Government assistance to implement a long term solution to Kingscliff Beach erosion.
