Purchasing Equipment and Supplying Invoice/Receipt to SLSNSW

As per the Circular, <u>Lifesaving Equipment Grant 2012-13</u>, the branch/club should carry out the following steps to receive the grant funds allocated:

1. Order Equipment

Branch/Club to contact the supplier to order allocated equipment. This needs to be actioned as soon as possible. If your equipment is from the Equipment List, please see the attached list for supplier details and order your approved equipment from these suppliers.

2. Obtain Tax Invoice or Tax Receipt

Obtain a tax invoice (made out to the branch/club)

Or

Purchase the equipment from the supplier and obtain a tax receipt for payment

Note: the invoice should be made to the branch/club not SLSNSW



3. Send Invoice or Receipt to SLSNSW

Supply SLSNSW with a copy of the supplier invoice or a copy of the tax receipt – by Thursday 31st January 2013.

Funds will only be allocated to the branch/club once an invoice or receipt for the item is received by SLSNSW.

4. Payment of Grant

SLSNSW will transfer the allocated grant \$\$\$ amount to the nominated branch/club account within 30 days of receiving the invoice or receipt.

5. Tax Invoice Followed Up With Tax Receipt

All branch/clubs who submit a tax invoice by 31st January 2013 must provide a tax receipt to SLSNSW by 28th February, 2013. This is for proof of purchase. Failure to do so will make the branch/club ineligible for future SLSNSW grants.

Funds will only be reimbursed for the branch approved items outlined in this letter. Other equipment you may have applied for that is not listed above will not be reimbursed under any circumstances.

Any delivery expenses are to be at the cost of the purchasing party.
