

SUMMARY OF REPORT:

Tender EC2014-135 was called to provide the necessary new facilities needed as part of the total redevelopment of Kingscliff North Holiday Park.

Tenders were officially invited in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Act 1993 and the NSW Local Government (General) Regulation 2005. Tender submissions closed at 4.00pm (local time) on Wednesday 24 September 2014 in the Tender Box located in the foyer at the Tweed Shire Council Civic and Cultural Centre, Murwillumbah NSW 2484.

RECOMMENDATION:

That:

- 1. The Tweed Coast Holiday Parks Reserve Trust awards the contract EC2014-135 Fabrication, Supply, Transport and Installation and Certification of Prefabricated buildings at the Kingscliff North Holiday Park to Wengold Pty Ltd trading as Eastcoast Homes & Park Cabins for the amount of \$1,031,509.09 (exclusive of GST).

Tender Background

Tender EC2014-135 Fabrication, Supply, Transport and Installation and certification of prefabricated buildings at the Kingscliff North Holiday Park was called to provide the necessary new facilities needed as part of the total redevelopment of Kingscliff North Holiday Park.

Tenders were officially invited in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Act 1993 and the NSW Local Government (General) Regulation 2005. Tender submissions closed at 4.00pm (local time) on Wednesday 24 September 2014 in the Tender Box located in the fover at the Tweed Shire Council Civic and Cultural Centre, Murwillumbah NSW 2484.

The total redevelopment of Kingscliff North Holiday Park forms part of the Tweed Coast Holiday Parks business plan which was adopted by the Trust in November 2010 and subsequently endorsed by Crown Lands. The above prefabricated buildings replace existing structures which by reason of age and aesthetic are no longer operationally viable.

Tender Advertising

Tenders were called by invitation to all suppliers previously appointed to the panel of providers previously established in accordance with the requirements of the Local Government Regulation 2005.

There were no addendums (Notice to Tenderers) issued before close of tender.

The Tender Evaluation was conducted by Trust's Tender Panel, consisting of Executive Manager, Tweed Coast Holiday Parks; Business Development Officer, Tweed Coast Holiday Parks; Construction Supervisor, Tweed Coast Holiday Parks; Contracts Engineer, Tweed Shire Council; and Internal Auditor, Tweed Shire Council as non-voting probity observer.

Tenders were officially invited in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Act 1993 and the NSW Local Government (General) Regulation 2005. Tender submissions closed at 4.00pm (local time) on Wednesday 1 October 2014 in the Tender Box located in the foyer at the Tweed Shire Council Civic and Cultural Centre, Murwillumbah NSW 2484.

The total redevelopment of Kingscliff North Holiday Park forms part of the Tweed Coast Holiday Parks business plan which was adopted by the Trust in November 2010 and subsequently endorsed by Crown Lands. The above civil works and services replace/improve upon existing works and services which by reason of age and functionality are no longer operationally viable.
