Does Council have development approval for these northern areas described above or funding allocated, and when exactly does Council intend to begin construction in these areas?

What would be the estimated average annual direct loss of revenue for Council i.e. from a reduction in sites available if Council allowed a Men's Shed the approximate size of a tennis court, to be located in the areas described above, and how are these costs calculated?
