Letter of Intent to host private function

The purpose of this letter is to inform council of our intent to host a **private function** at **102 Crooks Valley Road, Crystal Creek NSW 2484**, scheduled to be held in the first week of September 2017.

We have spoken to Chris Lonergan from Byron Bay Town Planner who assisted with the appropriate references.

Number of attendees

We expect 200 to 250 attendees to be present at any one time on the premises.

Other considerations

In the past, we have held similar events at the Civic Centre in Town but it would have created more traffic issues within the CBD being held during the workweek. We have a good relationship with the Civic Centre Manager, Mr Collin Eliot, who may be contacted to ascertain our credentials.

Traffic Management Program

We have 4x 12 seater mini vans and 2 x 7 seater cars transporting people between hotels and venue and have organised a parking space at a nearby property where we can transport the majority of the attendees from.

Approximately 30 cars will be parked in an area of our property closer to the road. These are reserved primarily for help teams such as cooking, etc.
