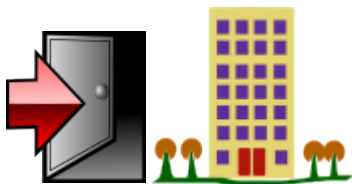

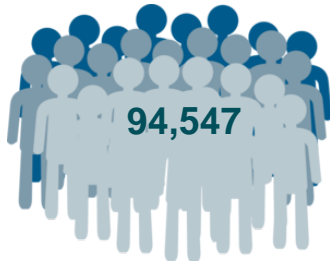

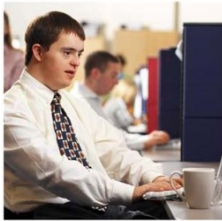
The plan has 4 parts

for

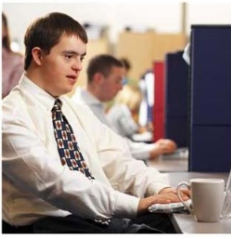
