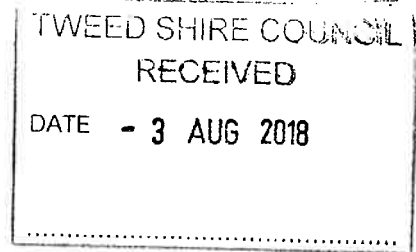

Dear Mr Green

I refer to my previous letter dated the 25 June 2018 regarding the transfer of state provisions for rural land sharing communities.

From 6 August 2018, provisions for rural landsharing communities will be contained in a new schedule in the State Environmental Planning Policy (Rural Lands) 2008. The provisions will be transferred to this SEPP from Schedule 1 of the State Environmental Planning Policy (Integration and Repeals) 2016. This will maintain the effect of the provisions after the self-repeal of the Integration and Repeals SEPP on 6 August 2018.

Your staff may need to update any systems that refer to the existing provisions for rural landsharing communities in the Integration and Repeals SEPP.

If your council decides to develop a local approach to dealing with rural land sharing communities in the future, it can do so through the planning proposal process. Further information on the planning proposal requirements will be available from the Department's Regional office.
