**We are building and maintaining an integrated, connected and accessible transport network**

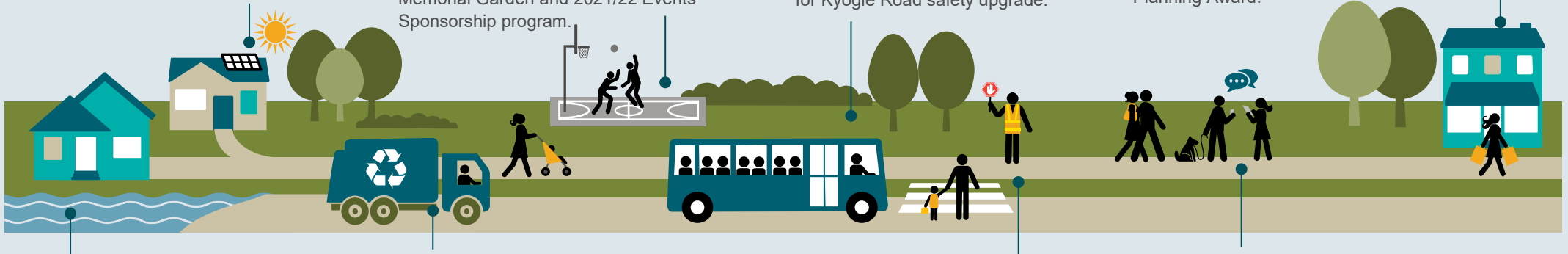
31 road projects completed or underway. Won Excellence in Engineering Award for Kyogle Road safety upgrade.

338 DAs submitted, 243 determined in this period. Planning Proposal for rural land sharing communities went on exhibition. Rural Land Strategy won National Planning Award.

Community flood experiences informed Tweed Flood Study to better prepare and respond to floods.

Tweed JUNKtion extended hours. Tested stormwater connections to help prevent sewage overflows.

Celebrated Youth Week and National Reconciliation Week. Provided free face masks to local small businesses. Consultation for Goorimahbah - Place of Stories Inclusive Park and Playspace. Declared Tweed housing emergency.

12 Council projects sought community feedback. 14200 visitors to Your Say Tweed.

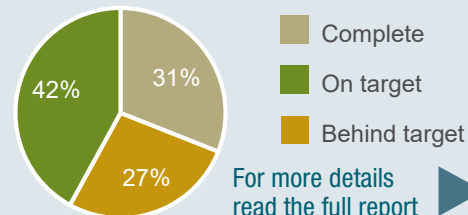
