Taking care of our environment

Awarded 5 River Health Grants; Completed River erosion stabilisation at Condong; Opened EOIs for Keeping Cats Safe at Home vouchers; 50 Clean Up Australia events in the Tweed; Relocated Osprey nest in Hastings Point.

Helping you be safe at home and the community with reliable essential services and infrastructure

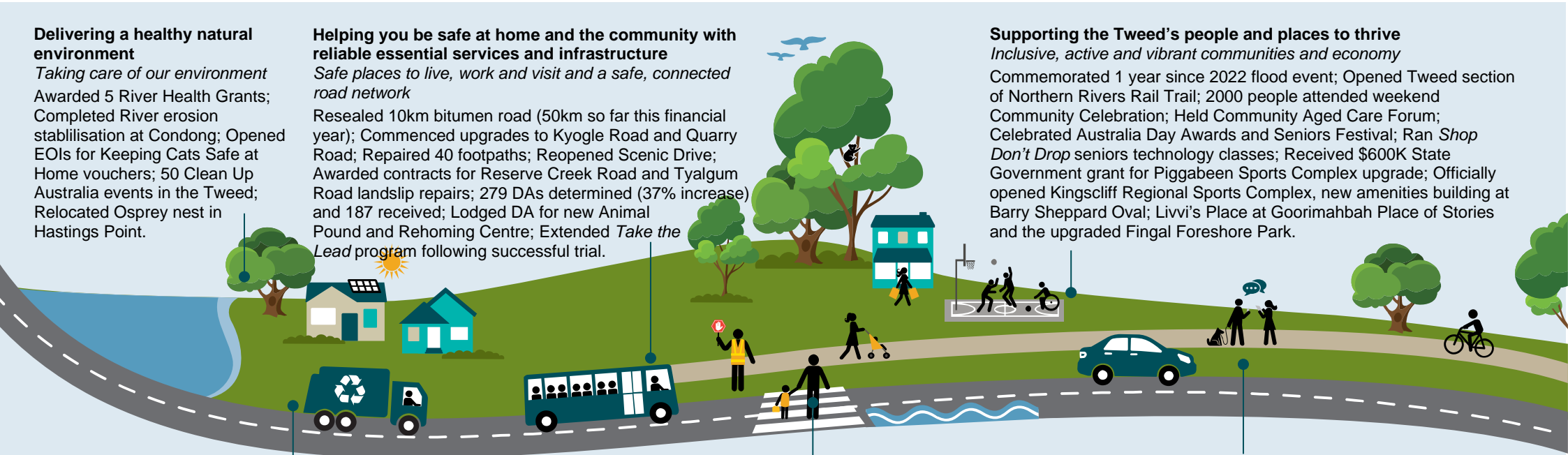
Safe places to live, work and visit and a safe, connected road network

Resealed 10km bitumen road (50km so far this financial year); Commenced upgrades to Kyogle Road and Quarry Road; Repaired 40 footpaths; Reopened Scenic Drive; Awarded contracts for Reserve Creek Road and Tyalgum Road landslip repairs; 279 DAs determined (37% increase) and 187 received; Lodged DA for new Animal Pound and Rehoming Centre; Extended *Take the Lead* program following successful trial.

Commemorated 1 year since 2022 flood event; Opened Tweed section of Northern Rivers Rail Trail; 2000 people attended weekend Community Celebration; Held Community Aged Care Forum; Celebrated Australia Day Awards and Seniors Festival; Ran *Shop Don't Drop* seniors technology classes; Received \$600K State Government grant for Piggabeen Sports Complex upgrade; Officially opened Kingscliff Regional Sports Complex, new amenities building at Barry Sheppard Oval; Livvi's Place at Goorimahbah Place of Stories and the upgraded Fingal Foreshore Park.

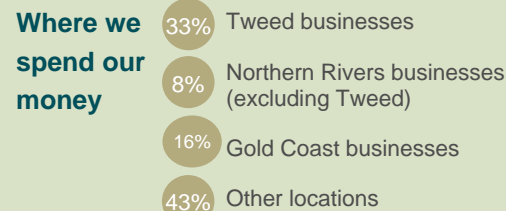

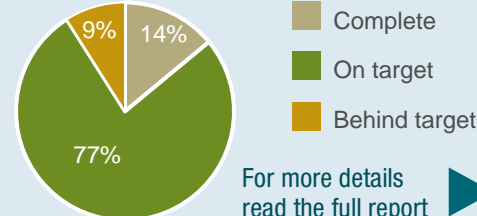
