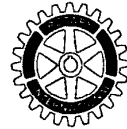

All participants are covered by Rotary insurance.

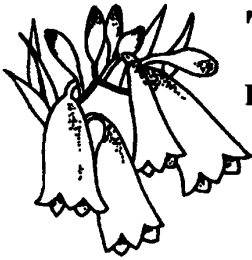
