I refer to your application of 30 March 2006 seeking Ministerial approval for increases to general income for the periods 2006/07 to 2012/13 inclusive for projects proposed in the Seven Year Plan.

The Minister has approved of the Council increasing its general income for two years only:

2006/07

7 60%

2007/08

8 00%

The approval is subject to the conditions set out in the attached instrument.

The decision not to approve of future years is based on community concerns over the increase and the necessity of certain projects. It is understood that council is in the process of developing an integrated asset management system. Such a system would support any future application should council wish to apply.

It should be noted that this approval is not an endorsement of the council's rating structure. The Minister's approval is on the basis that the Council makes and levies its rates according to the provisions of the Local Government Act 1993.

It is also on the understanding that council will continue to review its operations to identify where further efficiencies and savings can be achieved. By applying this special variational prior period shortfall or excess is eliminated.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1993

INSTRUMENT UNDER SECTION 508A(1) AND S548(3)(a)

- 1, Kerry Hickey, Minister for Local Government:
 - 1. In pursuance of the section 508(A) of the Local Government Act 1993 determine that the percentage by which Tweed Shire Council may increase its general income for:

2006/2007 is 7.6% above that for 2005/2006 2007/2008 is 8.0% above that for 2006/2007

- 2. The approval is subject to the following conditions:
 - the council will raise the additional increases for costs (1) associated with the "Seven Year Plan" as set out in Council's submission dated 30 March 2006 and the amended submission dated 14 June 2006;

 - the Council includes reports prepared under (ii) above in its (iv) annual report.
- 3. In pursuance of s548(3)(a) of the Local Government Act 1993 determine that Tweed Shire Council may make and levy the following minimum ordinary rates:
