Dear Sir,

At our last meeting we were informed that from now on we will be charged \$30 per hour for the use of the meeting room at the Banora Point Community Centre. This is a doubling of the previous rate.

We are not a money-making organization, but a residents' association which we understood, when we were encouraged by the Council to use these premises, would be exempt from charges. We were very disappointed to find that some groups were given exemption but not us, the main voice of the local people.

Some of our members have also heard from residents in other parts of the Shire that their residents' groups are given free access to their local halls for their meetings. If this is so we in Banora are being discriminated against by our own Council which should be encouraging resident participation & interest in Community affairs.

We are not fund-raisers & reject the notion that residents should have to pay to be able to have a voice in local matters. We feel that having to pay to attend will discourage residents from coming to meetings.

Therefore we request a review of Council's policy so that consistent charges are leveled across the Shire & that all actual resident associations be fee free. We see no reason why fund-raising groups or social groups cannot pay a hire fee but feel very strongly that the actual resident representative associations should be fee free.
