Financial Assistance to Licensed Not for Profit Native Animal Welfare Groups

Purpose

To establish principles to enable financial assistance on an annual basis, to be provided to licensed not for profit groups who provide care and rehabilitation to injured native wildlife.

Application

Council on an annual basis in conjunction with the preparation of the financial year budget may allocate financial assistance to licensed not for profit groups providing care and rehabilitation to injured native animals.

Consideration will be given to the allocation of funding in accordance with the number or variety of native species that each group is licensed to provide assistance. As an indication, base line funding for the care and rehabilitation of one species may commence at \$2500 per annum, to a maximum of \$5000 per annum to groups licensed in providing services to more than one native species.
